DOG POLICY

Well behaved dogs and other animals are welcome at Rhino Boulder, and we're happy to have them as part of the community. To make sure everyone feels comfortable and safe, we ask all dog owners to follow a few simple guidelines:

- **Supervision**: If you bring your dog, it must be either supervised by a non-climbing adult or securely leashed at one of our designated dog stations
- **Leads On**: Dogs must remain on a lead at all times—whether with a supervisor or at a dog station
- **Allowed areas**: dogs are welcome throughout the centre, but they should be kept off the mats and should not be taken into the gym
- Consideration for Others: Rhino is a space for everyone, including children and people who may be nervous around dogs. Please be mindful of how your dog's presence might affect others. Should any other centre user express discomfort with your dog being around, we would sadly have to ask you to take your dog away
- **Behaviour**: We expect all dogs to be calm, friendly, and non-disruptive. If a dog shows signs of aggressive or otherwise inappropriate behaviour, we may ask that it not return to the space
